Dear Region 2 High School/Middle School Principal and Student Activity Advisors,

In honor of the legacy and to provide an exceptional service learning opportunity for the young student leaders of your school (high school and middle school), the Region 2 Service Learning Advisory Committee, Project SHARE, HIPShasta Project, Cal-Serve, the California Dept. of Education, and Youth Service California are proud to sponsor a **Region 2 Youth Leadership Summit** at the Gaia Hotel in Anderson.

The day will begin at 10:00 a.m. with student presentations, information on service and community outreach, and how to make positive contributions to the school and community through student volunteerism, student projects, and group activism. Following lunch, students will be given tools and resources to help plan and organize student projects and programs that will have a community outreach focus.
